SCRUNCHIE SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- Take pattern piece and lay on piece of fabric
- Measure from grain line to edge of fabric to make sure it's lined up straight. Pin pattern piece to fabric
- Cut out pattern piece from fabric
- Pin right sides of fabric together and then start to sew about four inches down from the narrow side.
- Sew a 1/4 seam allowance all the way down to about four inches before the other end.
- Turn the tube of fabric so the outside of the fabric is facing out and the seam is on the inside
 of the tube
- Take the short wide ends and match together and pin
- Sew a 1/4 inch seam allowance along the edge of the fabric
- press the seam and turn it so you have a circle
- Take the elastic and put a safety pin on one end of it
- Hold one end of the elastic and thread the other end into the tube through to the other end
- Have the elastic through the tube from each end and put the ends together one on top of the other and then sew the elastic pieces together
- Then take the open ends of the fabric and turn under and sew with hand stitches or machine
